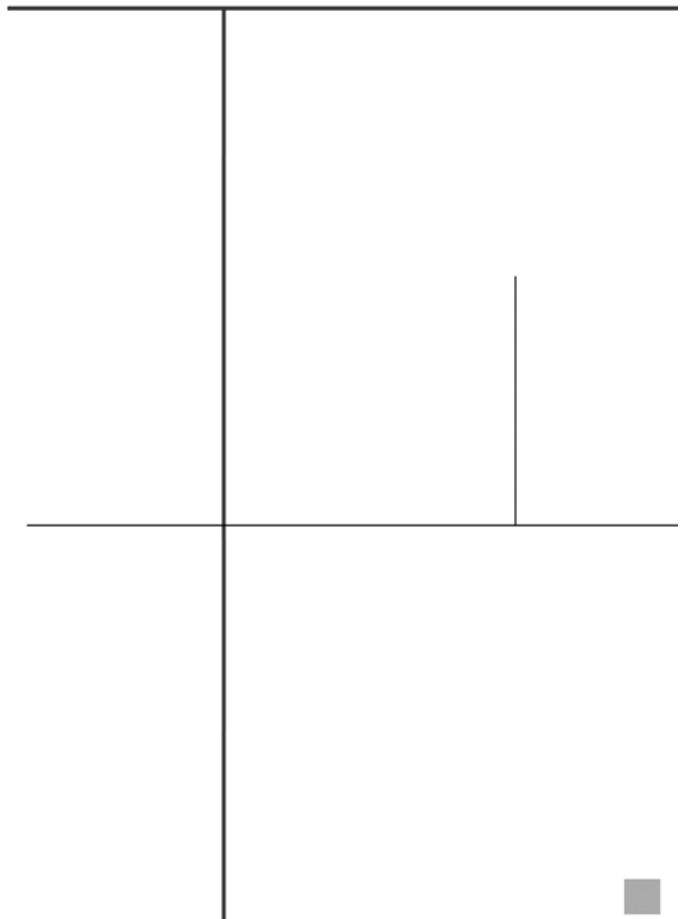




Megarena™ User Guide



Congratulations! Now you are the owner of the best mobile paintball arena - Megarena™. Megarena™ is actually a cross-functional product which can be used for paintball field as well as inflatable tent once all netting panels are changed to fabric panels. With the bright color and eye catching size, it is an excellent advertising media for both your business and other merchants.

Please read the following user guides first before you start to use the package.

Packaging & Contents

- Megarena™ – packaging color may vary;
- 2-4 electric blowers depending on the arena size;
- Tie down and pegs;
- Smart-Bunker™ package if it comes with Megarena™;
- Artificial turf package if it comes with Megarena™;

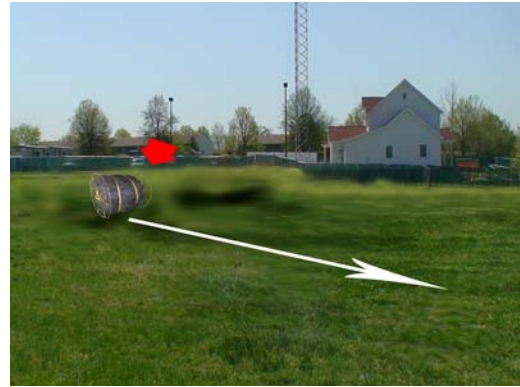
Before Setup

- Check the ground and remove all sharp obstacles;
- Layout size should be at least 10' wider and 20' longer than the arena size, make sure there is no trees, or power cable go over or protrude inside the layout area;
- Check weather forecast to ensure the wind is under 25 mph and no upcoming rain and/or storm;
- Check power supply;
- Check the potential field layout and possible setup orientation;



Setup

Place the wheel at one end of the layout area in the center line; If the arena doesn't come with wheel, place arena package at one end of the layout area in the center line;

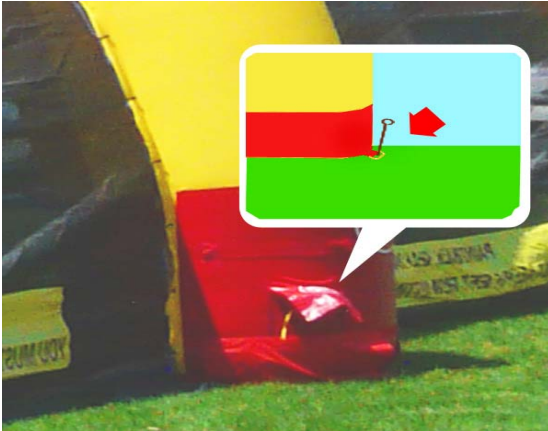


Carefully unwind the wheel (or unroll the arena package) toward the other end. **You must** be very careful during the unwinding so that the wheel will not crash any fabric part. Do not pull and drag too hard, which may tear off the fabric and seam;

After unwinding, carefully spread out the arena. Make sure the arena is facing down by checking the lettering "Megarena" on the front or back arch is not upside down. **Close all air-releasing openings** - there are openings on top of center beam and each arch legs;



Attach blowers to the air inlet. Make sure the blowers are located on the same side where there is no spectators standing and having access to them. Fencing may be needed, if required, to keep away spectators from accessing the power supply and blower working area. Also make sure all power and cables are in good, dry situation and all connections are good and tight;



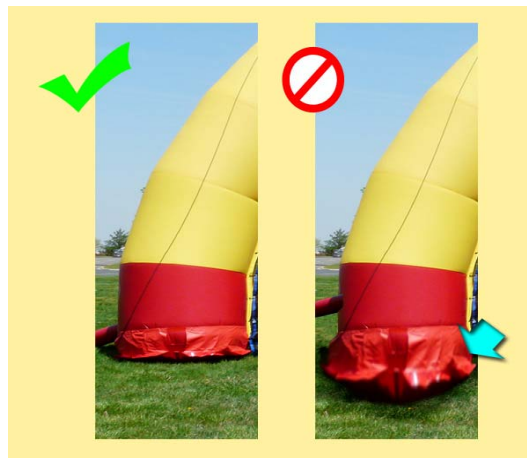
There are 4 ropes tying the bottom D rings of the each arch, holding the arch to avoid the leg split during the inflation. **Make sure 4 ropes are connected properly before inflating;** You can turn on the blower one by one and the arena starts inflating up, you need to go inside the arena and push up the central top beam to help it get up so that it can go up easier.



When the arena is up, adjust and line up arches to ensure the field sits stably;

Air Pressure Adjustment

- Adjusting internal pressure of the air structure of the Megarena™ is important to provide you a stable arena and the longest product life;
- If the bottoms of the arches are popping out instead of flat, then you may need to release some air out to reduce the pressure inside;
- Open the zipper on the other size of arch (the side without the blowers) to lower the internal pressure and then firmly cover the Velcro flap;



Anchor Down

- Tie down is required for the arena after you get it setup so that it can resist wind impact;
- All arch bottoms comes with D rings for tie down use, use the metal peg and/or weight items for tie down;
- On each arch, around joints between side beams and arches, there are also D rings for tie down use, use tie down cords to tie down;

Inspection Before Game

- Inspect the whole arena by walking through to ensure the arena is totally enclosed and there is no opening where paintballs may go out;
- Check all bunkers are laid out right and tie down properly;
- All power cables and plugs are in good and safe situations;
- Whole arena setup is in safe and good operating situation;

During The Operation

- Make sure power supply are in good situation, check gas tank level if you use the generators for power;
- Check the tie down in good situation
- Check the weather situation to know any coming rain/storm or wind;
- Take down the arena temporarily as needed if the wind or rain is coming by turning off the blowers;

Taking Down

- Remove all bunkers and others things out of arena first;
- Connect the 4 ropes between the bottom of each arch back so that next time, the setup will be easy;
- Turn off the blowers and open all air outlet openings;
- Once the air is out, folding both side toward center beam, and make sure the width of the folding will be smaller than the wheel width;
- Start winding the field back to the wheel;
- Make sure the wheel will not crash any arena body part;
- Wrap and tie the wheel after winding;

Cleaning and Storage

- Using water only to clean the arena, never use detergent and power wash, it voids the warranty and may damage the arena;
- Make sure the arena is in dry situation before you pack it and put it in storage;
- Set up the arena and get it dry totally if it get wet;
- Store the arena in dry and good ventilation area;

Lighting System (optional)

- Lighting system is optional, not included with the package;
- Lighting system includes 3 units of 500W flood light with power cables;
- Using rope going over the whole top beam and create 3 location for light hanging purpose;
- Semi-setup the arena so as to get the cable set up first;



- Cable should go from the outside of the field into the light location;
- Hang the light in the rope and plug in the power cable;
- When the arena is totally up, then plug in the cable into the power;
- Do not use lighting system during the wet environment or raining day;
- Always check the cable and all connections before each use;

Others

- Please read the blower user guide for additional information on operating blowers;

Warranty

- The Megarena™ has a six month warranty from the date you receive the arena; The Megarena™ is covered against quality and material defect as well as craftsmanship under normal intended use.
- The warranty doesn't cover any wear and damage caused by improper use and operation, including but not limited to rough handling, abuse, tampering, improper power supplies, unauthorized repair and maintained.
- Warranty covers only one way freight to mainland USA, it is your responsibility to send the product back to us for repair or replacement;
- Warranty service - always call or email us to report problem and get the instruction on how to get warranty service.
