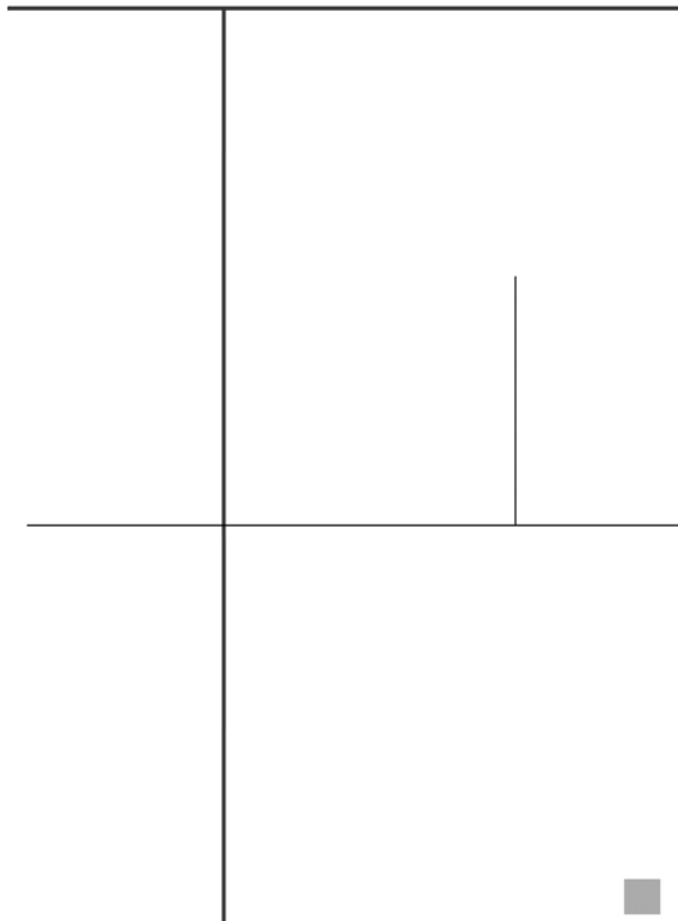




# Smart-Arena<sup>TM</sup> User Guide



---

Congratulations! Now you are the owner of the best inflatable paintball arena - Smart-Arena™. Smart-Arena™ is actually a cross-functional product which can be used for paintball field as well as inflatable soccer field and football field, etc. With the bright color and eye catching size, it is an excellent advertising media for both your business and other merchants.

Please read the following user guides first before you start to use the package.

### **Packaging & Contents**

- Smart-Arena™ – packaging color may vary;
- Electric blowers— quantity of blowers varies per the arena size;
- Tie down and pegs— quantity of tie downs and pegs varies per arena size;
- Smart-Bunker™ package if it comes with Smart-Arena™;
- Artificial turf package if it comes with Smart-Arena™;
- Any other items you may order with the package.

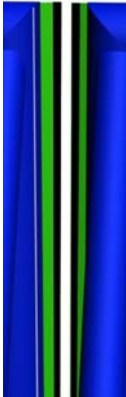
### **Before Setup**

- Check the set up arena and remove all sharp obstacles;
- Layout size should be at least 10' wider and 20' longer than the arena size, make sure there is no trees, or power cable go over or protrude inside the layout area;
- Check weather forecast to ensure the wind is under 25 mph and no upcoming rain and/or storm;
- Check power supply;
- Check the potential field layout and possible setup orientation;



## Setup

Take out the arena wall panels and find out the entrance panel, place it at the location for entrance. Then line up other panels to form the field as shown. Make sure all sides with air inlet and base facing outside.



Find out the edge of each wall panels and match them with the edge of next wall panels. Start from one end, connect both edges together by pushing the Velcro to each other tightly.

Before blow up, all wall panels should be connected together so that the air flow can pass through. Locate the air cover at the side the panel base. Connect all panels in the straight line using the straight connector. Connect the four corners using the curve connectors as shown.



Fill the water sand bag with water and open the side opening of panel base and put water sand bags inside the base. Each base needs two water sand bags.

Check the water sand bag to make sure no leakage before put into base. If there is leak, do not use it. Water leaked inside the base will be hard to clean and may cause mold.



There are D rings (loops) for tie down ropes. Hook the tie down rope to each D ring before inflating the arena.

Also connect blowers to the air inlet tube locating at the outside panel base. If possible, try to locate blowers in each side so that the air flow can be more smooth and efficient.

Check around each panel to make sure all air outlets (openings) are closed.

Once the blowers are connected, you may turn on the blowers to inflate the arena. During the inflation, you may adjust the location of each panel to line up the arena. You may need to pull the tie down rope to help arena to stand up.

### **Anchor Down**

- Tie down is required for the arena after you get it setup so that it can resist wind impact;
- All arch bottoms comes with D rings for tie down use, use the metal peg and/or weight items for tie down;
- The arena comes with water weight bags which can be used for hold down the arena;
- Make sure tie downs are made on all 4 sides of arena to ensure the stability;
- Always check to comply with any local requirements in regard of using this kind of arena.

### **Inspection Before Game**

- Inspect the whole arena by walking through to ensure the arena is totally enclosed and there is no opening where paintballs may go out;
- Check all bunkers are laid out right and tie down properly, no over inflation;
- Check to make sure all safety signs (not included) are displayed at the required locations. All field rules and safety rules are available for public view
- All power cables and plugs are in good and safe situations;

### **During The Operation**

- Make sure power supplies are in good condition, check gas tank level if you use the generators for power;
- Check the tie down in good condition;
- Check the weather situation to know any coming rain/storm or wind;
- Take down the arena temporarily as needed if the wind or rain is coming by turning off the blowers;

### **Taking Down**

- Remove all bunkers and others things out of arena first or move all bunkers to the center area of the arena so that the deflating arena will not cover on bunkers;
- Remove all water weight bags from the arena if you use water weight bags;
- Turn off the blowers and open all air outlet openings;
- Disconnect all panels from each other so that each panel can be packed individually;
- Once the air is out, folding wall panel to the size of your packing container.
- Make sure to clean out any sharp items, such as sticks and gravels etc. during the packing so that these sharp items will not be included in the packaging to avoid possible damage to arena.
- Make sure clean out any water if there is any, to avoid mold;
- Take down bunkers by open the Smart-Valve™. If you have two way inflator, you can pack the bunker in more compact size by sucking the air out. Make sure put the valve back once you suck the air out.

## Cleaning and Storage

- Using water only to clean the arena, never use detergent and power wash, it voids the warranty and may damage the arena;
- If you use regular paintball, make sure to clean up all bunkers and arenas right after daily use before the paint dries up.
- Make sure the arena is in dry condition before you pack it and put it in storage;
- Set up the arena and get it dry totally if it gets wet or is used in the rain;
- Store the arena in dry and good ventilation area;

## Warranty

- The Smart-Arena™ has a six month warranty from the date you receive the arena; The Smart-Arena™ is covered against quality and material defect as well as craftsmanship under normal intended use.
- The warranty doesn't cover any wear and damage caused by improper use and operation, including but not limited to rough handling, abuse, tampering, improper power supplies, unauthorized repair and maintained.
- Warranty covers only one way freight to mainland USA, it is your responsibility to send the product back to us for repair or replacement;
- Warranty service - always call or email us to report problem and get the instruction on how to get warranty service.
